What is Child Protection about?

All of the adults around you think that your health, safety and welfare are very important.

In our school, we respect you and help to protect your rights.

We do our best to help you make progress in your learning.

We teach you how to recognise risks and dangers in different situations and how to protect yourself and stay safe.



It's important that you know where to go to get help if you are worried or unhappy about something.

How will we try to protect children?

We provide a safe environment for children to learn in.

We want to help to ensure that children remain safe at home and school.

Don't keep it a secret if:

Someone is bullying you;

Saying funny things to you that you do not like or upsets you;

Touching you in places you know are wrong;

Trying to give you tablets, cigarettes, drugs or alcohol;

Hitting you or hurting you;

Sending unkind messages on the internet or to your phone.
