	Separate competitions for "small" and "large" schools.  A small school should have fewer than 100 children in KS2 and no more than 25 in Year 6.
Pathway	From the tournament pupils can be selected for the U12 Derbyshire teams, boys and girls, to go initially to a selection event and if selected they will represent Derbyshire in an East Midlands event.

### **Derbyshire Primary Take 8 Mini-Basketball Rules.**

### **Modifications to the Basketball Rules:**

- Each game will be running clock. The length and number of periods will be determined by the number of teams involved and the time allocated for the tournament. Ideally 4 x 6minutes.
- The games will be played as 4 v 4.
- A team MUST be a minimum of 8 players (4 boys & 4 girls) and no less.
- Boys play in the 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> period, Girls play in the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> period.
- A squad size of 10 players (5 boys & 5 girls) is recommended.
- Man to Man defence.
- Teams winning by 15 points or more must not play a full court press. Referees should assist the coach in applying this modification.
- No free throws: 1 point is awarded to a player in a situation where 2 free throws are normally given, *unless it goes in then the basket will score 2 points*. Possession is also given, to the fouled team, from the side-line

### **Basketball Rules not applied:**

- No timeouts
- No penalty for a team who does not cause the ball to go into its frontcourt within eight (8) seconds.
- No rear court violation.
- No penalty if a team does not attempt a shot for a field goal within twenty-four (24) seconds.
- There are no free throws.
- No 3-point shots are awarded.

### **Spectators & Parents**

We expect fair play from everybody involved with the festival. The organisers can ask any
person exhibiting inappropriate behaviour to leave the facility and not return until the
tournament is over.

	Large Schools: The team can be boys only or include any number of girls in the team.	
	Small Schools: This competition is for small schools only. A small school should have	
	fewer than 100 children in KS2 and no more than 25 in Year 6. The team can be boys	
	only or include any number of girls in the team.	
	Girls: This competition is for girls only.	
Basic Overview	Small group round robins (3 points for a win, 1 for a draw and 0 for a defeat).	
	Top 1 or 2 teams from each group to qualify for the knockout stages. This will depend	
	on the number of teams attending etc.	
	Number of knockout rounds will be determined nearer the time depending on	
	number of teams entering etc.	
	Match duration will also be subject to the above but as a guide will be around 10	
	minutes per game. Size 4 ball to be used.	
	The decision of the referee regarding facts connecting with play are final.	
	Additional Information	
	All teams must provide a playing kit so that all their players are wearing the same	
	colour with a different colour for the goalkeeper (in the event of a colour clash, bibs	
	will be provided).	
	Shin pads MUST be worn by ALL players.	
	Games will be played on grass or artificial turf, so please ensure players are wearing	
	appropriate footwear (Metal studs are NOT permitted on the turf artificial turf	
	surfaces). Details will be confirmed nearer the time.	
	All jewellery is to be removed before entering the field of play.	
	Further guidance on both rules and tournament formats will be provided at a	
	Managers Meeting at the start of each event to ensure that information given is	
	specific to that particular day.
