Team Teaching CPD & Upskilling

Our team teaching programme is based around staff being based in your school for either a full day or an afternoon for the full academic year. Our experience has found that consistency of staff in your school result in a greater output for the school and young people.

We encourage our schools to ensure that staff are present in any PE lesson and our staff will work with teachers to develop their understanding of the subject. Whilst the majority of our staff aren't teacher trained they have worked within education for a number of years and are exceptional in what they do.

Scheme of Work

Piloted and developed by Amber Valley SSP, we can provide a high quality product that schools and teachers can utilise to develop the subject. These plans are progressive against all year groups and link into the new curriculum as well also encouraging 'think' and 'feel' development. We believe that although a child may not be an outstanding performer of an activity that they can still be an outstanding thinker/tactician and our plans encourage this to happen.

PE Assessment & Baseline Testing

Through the Sports Premium Web App, schools accessing our PE & Sports Coaching Provision will have access to the online assessment portal that will align and support the curriculum and scheme of work that we are delivering. Our staff can also be on hand to complete the PE assessment of your students.

Competition Engagement Support

Our curriculum map and extra-curricular programme is set for the year which is aligned to the school competition programme thus giving greater transition for students to develop the building blocks of the activity and then follow on to the competition.

Our staff will liaise closely with your PE coordinator to ensure that students have the best chance of competing at a district level and beyond.
