MTP: Y3 Autumn 1a: Getting to know you

This unit is based upon:

Introducing your class to Spain and the idea of speaking in Spanish. Practise of basic greetings, feelings and saying name. Children are encourage to feel they are about to acquire "super skills".

- Practise pronunciation and intonation skills in a new language.
- Begin to explore memory techniques.
- Experiment with the speaking, reading, writing of individual words and simple phrases


